Northern Ireland – Make a paper plate shamrock

- Cut out three circles from a piece of paper/card (or use a paper plate
- Paint the front of the circles green and allow it to dry
- Cut a V shape in each circle
- Draw on a central vein on each circle using a darker pen or glitter glue
- Arrange the circles into a shamrock shape and glue or tape together
- Take a rectangular piece of card, colour it green and tape of glue it as a stem
