Introduction

Northumberland Scouts have organised a month-long Virtual Camp, ending with an attempt to set the world record for the Largest Virtual Camp on 30/04/2020, when we'd like as many people as possible to participate.

All you must do is camp @ Home and follow the rules below (there are some 44th only ones).

Each Young Person who participates will get a Virtual Certificate for joining in and **1** Night Away for each night they participate in (as long as they aren't sleeping in their bed). Meaning you could get up to an extra **30** Nights Away if you take on the challenge (**01/04/2020 to 30/04/2020**).

That's in addition to the badges you could earn by following the Group's virtual programme.

The Rules (Remember you have a month to complete these tasks)

- Pack a bag for camp there will be an activity on the Facebook page soon
- Build a den at home / pitch a tent in the garden / hang up a hammock (wherever you can)
- Sleep in your shelter of choice for at least one night
- Use your imagination to build a virtual camp fire
- Improvise a flag and flag pole for your camp
- Decorate the "Thankyou Key Workers Poster" published on the Group Facebook page
- Particiapate #GreatIndoors activities from 44th Colchester Scout Group Scout Activity
- Help with the cooking of a meal
- Try and complete a good turn (help out) around the home every day
- Keep a diary of your experience while "on camp"
